CANOE EXPEDITION KIT LIST

Packing for a canoe expedition requires careful planning to ensure you have everything you need while keeping your gear dry and organized. The specific items you pack may vary depending on the duration, location, and type of canoe expedition you're undertaking, but here's a general packing list to get you started:

Items marked with a **Pare** linked to suitable options

Canoe and Paddling Gear: (Provided by Alexander Adventures)

- Canoe: set up for expedition paddling
- Paddles: One or two paddles per person, depending on your preference.
- PFD (Personal Flotation Device): A properly fitted PFD for each participant.
- Wetsuit
- Waterproof Cag
- Dry Bags

Camping Gear: (Provided by Alexander Adventures)

Clothing:

- Quick-Dry Clothing: Lightweight, moisture-wicking clothing suitable for the weather.
- Sun Protection: Wide-brimmed hat, sunglasses, and sunscreen (SPF 30+).
- Rain Gear: Waterproof jacket and pants to stay dry in wet conditions.
- Footwear: Closed-toe water shoes or trainers with good grip.
- Neoprene Booties: Insulated booties for colder conditions.
- Swimsuit: For swimming or wading.
- Insulating Layers: Depending on the season and location.

Personal Items:

- ID and Documentation: Identification, permits, and emergency contact information.
- Cash: For emergency use and any purchases along the way.
- Mobile Phone: In a waterproof case or dry bag.
- Toiletries: Toothbrush, toothpaste, biodegradable soap, and a small towel.
- Insect Repellent: To protect against bugs.
