St Abbs is renowned for its rugged and dramatic coastline As a sea kayaker, you'll be treated to stunning views of towering cliffs, hidden coves, and crystal-clear waters. The area is part of the Berwickshire Coast Path, which provides access to a variety of paddling routes with different levels of difficulty.

One of the highlights of sea kayaking in St. Abbs is the opportunity to encounter diverse wildlife. The waters around St. Abbs are home to seals, seabirds, and even dolphins. Paddlers often spot grey seals basking on the rocks or curiously swimming alongside their kayaks. Birdwatchers will appreciate the chance to see puffins, kittiwakes, and guillemots nesting on the cliffs.







# ST ABBS ITIN EARPY

0730 - Meet at Base: This is the starting point for your sea kayaking adventure. You'll gather at our base in Dunston, where you'll meet your guides and fellow kayakers. Here, you might receive a safety briefing, get your equipment sorted, and have the opportunity to ask any questions before heading out.

0900 - Arrive in St Abbs: After the initial meet-up, you'll make your way to the charming village of St. Abbs. It's a scenic coastal village with a small harbor, which serves as a popular launching point for sea kayaking expeditions.

0945/10.00 - On the water: For your first taste of Berwickshire sea paddling: This is when you'll begin your sea kayaking adventure. You'll likely receive more detailed instructions about the day's route, safety protocols, and some tips for paddling in the area. It's an exciting moment as you launch your kayaks and start exploring the beautiful Berwickshire coast from the water.

12.00 - Stop for lunch: in one of the many beautiful coves: After a few hours of paddling and taking in the stunning coastal scenery, it's time for a well-deserved break ensuring you have the energy needed for the rest of your sea kayaking journey.

12.30 - Continue the Journey: After lunch, you'll resume your sea kayaking journey, exploring more of the rugged coastline, perhaps discovering hidden spots and encountering local wildlife along the way.

**15.00 - Off the water:** Your sea kayaking adventure will come to a close around 3:00 PM. You'll likely disembark from your kayaks and take some time to reflect on the day's experiences.

16.00 - Depart for home: With your sea kayaking adventure in St. Abbs behind you, it's time to head back to your starting point or make your way home, depending on your travel arrangements
